

EAST WINDSOR POLICE DEPARTMENT VENDOR PERMIT APPLICATION



Instructions:

- 1) Applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
- 2) Applicant must provide copy of their Connecticut Sales Tax Permit.
- 3) Applicant must provide copy of their Health Certificate if selling food items.
- 4) Fingerprints are required for FBI and Connecticut Criminal History Background Check.
The processing fee of \$88.25 must be paid by bank check or money order (payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut").
- 5) Advise the Dispatcher when the application is turned in that fingerprints are needed.
Fingerprints cannot be processed without the fully completed application. Fingerprints cannot be done in advance.
- 6) Once approved, the applicant will be contacted via the phone number provided on the vendor permit application.
- 7) The permit fee of \$25.00 must be paid by bank check or money order (payable to East Windsor Police Dept).
- 8) Permits are nontransferable and are valid only for the dates requested on the vendor permit application (up to 1 year).
