Additionally, once dispatched, you will receive a text message from EWPD indicating the officer enroute to your location.

We genuinely value your feedback, but participation in the surveys is entirely optional. If you prefer not to take part, you can simply choose not to respond. It's important to note that this program is not designed for formal complaints, reporting emergencies, or addressing criminal activities. For such matters, please continue to use 911 or contact us at 860-292-8240.

Please be aware that landline phone calls are not eligible to receive surveys through this program. Thank you for being an integral part of our community, and we look forward to hearing your thoughts.
